Coach parking

There is a coach drop off point also in Barton Square. Coaches will be required to drop here, and then park in the main Coach Park until collecting later.

Travelling by train

The nearest mainline train station from The Trafford Centre is Manchester Piccadilly. From Piccadilly, the best option is to take the X50 bus straight to The Trafford Centre. Other options including taking a taxi, or joining the Metrolink tram to Stretford and then the Shuttle Bus.

Arriving at the attraction

With your pre-purchased group tickets, you can join our pre-booked ticket entrance. Please note that group tickets are not available on the day, so if you haven't pre-purchased tickets, you won't get a group discount.

Cash machines

There are cash machines at Barton Square of The Trafford Centre

Disabled access

LEGOLAND Discovery Centre is accessible for all, with certain restrictions applying to our two rides.

Eating and drinking

LEGOLAND Discovery Centre has a small café serving drinks and snacks including fresh fruit, sandwiches and children's lunch box packs. The Trafford Centre boasts a fantastic range of restaurants, and therefore it is possible to leave the attraction and return later – just ask for a pass out.

Smoking

The entire attraction is indoor, hence smoking is not permitted.
