The Sanctuary is set in a valley of outstanding beauty and therefore has steep sections and steps to some paths, making wheelchair use difficult. Approximately 80% of the Sanctuary is accessible by a motorised wheelchair. The Sanctuary does provide a seasonal Safari bus to transport visitors from reception to the main pools on site.
