How to get there

Follow the A47 from Norwich or the A12 from Lowestoft into Great Yarmouth, then follow the brown tourist signs to the Seafront and SEA LIFE.

Arriving by train then follow the signs from the station to the Seafront and SEA LIFE. The SEA LIFE Centre is located adjacent to the Wellington Pier on the seafront. It will take about 25 minutes to walk from the station to the seafront.

Car/coach parking

There is pay and display car parking all along the seafront during the summer season, it's free from November – March. Various car parks are all well signposted along Marine Parade.

Arrival

In order to get your group in as smoothly and quickly as possible we suggest that the group leader reports to Reception and all other members of the group wait on the opposite side of the lobby. Your co-operation in helping to keep the main walkway clear would be much appreciated.

Baby talk

You can access all areas with pushchairs and double buggies and you'll also find baby changing facilities in the toilets.

Disabled access

We want everyone to enjoy their Group Fun Day to the full and we welcome guests with disabilities. The centre is fully wheelchair accessible, including disabled electric motor scooters

Only registered assistance dogs are allowed into the centre.
